



HISTORY OF

TAUHEEDUL MUSLIMEEN TRUST

auheedul Muslimeen Trust (TMT) was born as a link between those willing to learn but lacking the means to do so, and philanthropists eager to contribute towards positive change in the society.

Concerned over the future of a young boy struggling to mobilise funds for his graduation, the Trust's founder Dr S Kalbe Sadiq wrote to a friend in Mumbai. This friend, (Late) Jafar Ali Aseel responded by sponsoring the boy's university studies.

Soon, however, it was clear that isolated charity would not serve as a long-term solution to this deep-rooted problem. Hence, Dr Sadiq envisioned an institution that will empower underprivileged children with education and enable them to sustain themselves and their family.

This idea manifested into the formation of TMT in 1984. Over the years, TMT has broadened its scope; Today, apart from aiding the education of underprivileged students, TMT is a known name in training, healthcare and rehabilitations of the disadvantaged. In the following pages, we present programs that highlight TMT's major accomplishments.

On the other hand, the common man doesn't abstain from employing his young ones in the dingy kaamdaani and zari quarters to add to the meager family income. Burqa-clad women are driven out of the comfort of their homes since morning to look for a livelihood.

Fabrication and self-centeredness have become predominant in the society. But let's not get disheartened by the present scenario.

The Trust deems itself responsible for providing education to the under-privileged children and we are glad that it has been able to fetch a positive change in their environment. A sight of this can be seen in the slum dwellings where free education schemes are introduced for these young ones.

Solution to the problem:

For the betterment of our society, it is crucial to provide education to the poor and downtrodden children of our community. Eradication of illiteracy is the first step towards this direction but there are many

more avenues to conquer. The self-confidence required in our community can only be achieved through ideological revolution. The founding stone of major revolutions around the world in countries like Russia, France or entire Europe was based on it. Such revolution being the epicentre of major uprisings in the world is imperative for the progress of our community as a whole.





- In line with the belief that education is the right of every child, Unity Mission School was started in 1999 with nine underprivileged children.
- The mission school provides free education to students facing socio-economic obstacles in the way of learning.
- Students also provided transport and medical facilities as well as uniforms, books and stationery free of cost.
- Today, 1350 children attend classes from nursery level to grade XII.
- Students have access to all the existing infrastructure of Unity College.

LUCKNOW

- Unity Private Industrial Training Institute (UPITI) came into being in 1995 with an aim to bridge the gap between industry expectations and student skills.
- The endeavor is being supported by Mr. Shokat Alibhai and Mr Mustafa Kassam
- Initially, the center operated with a few enrolments in a small shed at Unity College campus where the students were offered five trades affiliated with National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT).
- Today, 243 full-time students are trained in 9 trades. This was made possible by an extension of infrastructure to an overall 11,000 square feet of covered area.
- · About 371 students are enrolled in short-term courses with high value in job market.
- Collaboration with CAD Centre, a leading AutoCAD training Institute of India for compulsory training for Draughtsman Civil trainees.
- Campus placements to help skilled manpower get job opportunities.



ALLAHABAD

- Unity College started functioning in 1993 from a modest rented building located in densely populated area of Kareli, Allahabad. Established under the management of Imamiya Education Society, the school has grown into a full-fledged English medium intermediate college affiliated with ICSE New Delhi.
- The college houses 32 classrooms, physics, chemistry, biology and computer labs, library, snack bar and a play area built over 12,300 sq ft of land.
- To cater to the needs of children coming from villages and having little or no education,
 Unity Intermediate College Saidpur was established on the sparsely populated outskirts of Allahabad. Affiliated with UP Board, the college follows the Hindi medium pattern and is spread over 12 bighas of land.
- Following the pattern of Unity Mission School in Lucknow, a similar school was formed in Dandupur, Naini Allahabad to provide cost free education to 200 students of the village.
- The three schools have now grown to accommodate educational needs of above 2600 students.

MEDICAL AID PROGRAM


Our generous donors have enabled us to bear a share of the costs for diagnostic, procedural and medication fees. TMT offers healthcare assistance to people living below the poverty line through a network of hospitals. As part of a cooperative partnership between hospitals and TMT, patients are treated at affordable rates in several hospitals. These include SGPGIMS, King George's Medical University and Balrampur Hospital in Lucknow. A majority of the students were treated at the Era's Hospital in Lucknow with the direct support of the Canadian Jafari Muslim Foundation in Toronto, Canada.



The Life Saver Program is offered through us by the Sajjadiyya Trust in Toronto, Canada. It has helped many critical care patients in life-threatening conditions to receive intensive care treatments.

Mr. Raza resident of Old Lucknow and cardiac patient for four years was left stunned when he was told by the hospital that his ailment was in an advanced stage and required valve replacement. A zardozi worker and father to six children, Raza and his family together earned Rs 5000 per month and thus not in a position to bear the expense of surgery- estimated at Rs 1,65,000.

Here, Tauheedul Muslimeen Trust pitched in and bore the cost of the entire surgery which was conducted in Gujarat due to the severity and urgency of the case. Other than this, an amount of Rs 10000/was also paid to the applicant for food and accommodation expenses in Gujarat. Eventually, the surgery was performed, the operation was successful and by the grace of Allah (swt) Mr Raza is living a normal life and supporting his family.



GENERAL AID PROGRAM

TMT continues to provide assistance to those finding it difficult to make ends meet. Almost 2150 people have received financial aid, Ramzan food hampers, winter blankets and essential home repairs.

In addition, the institution provides regular monthly ration and medical aid to families who have lost their breadwinners. This is in line with our philosophy of rendering relief to the distressed and our vision of a more equitable world. TMT is hopeful of providing generous support to more such cases in the future and work towards furthering the cause of humanity and betterment of the society.




Nafees Jahan, 65, has to cater to the needs of a big family in a meagre income. Widow of late Irshad Husain, a resident of Muftigani, Nafees has four daughters, of which two are married while the other two are living with her. Her daughters are involved in kamdani work and the earning of her only son is not sufficient to support the family. Nafees bears the expenses of a handicapped granddaughter, abandoned by her parents. The family is sozkhan from last 3 generations but never asks for any money for performing this ritual. TMT assists the family with medical aid, ramzan food hamper, and blanket in winters & recently paid around one lakh for the renovation of her house.




